



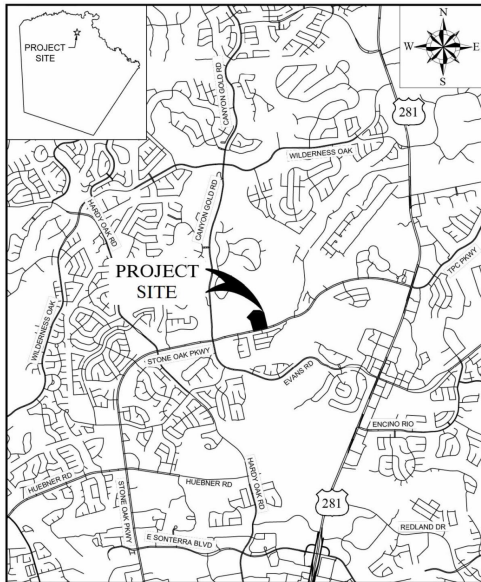

Asian Resource Center Project Progress



Project Site

After much demographic study and site searching, ARCSA has identified 4.283 acres of land on Stone Oak Parkway, San Antonio for the Asian Resource Center project.

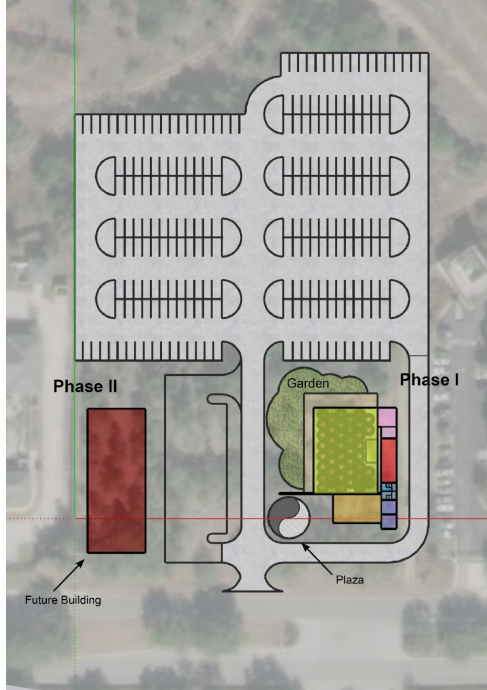
The lot is part of an existing plat and is located on the north side of Stone Oak Parkway, at the intersection of Tynedale Trace and Stone Oak Parkway. The existing condition of the site is undeveloped with no existing structures and substantial tree cover present. The adjacent lots to the east and west are both fully developed. To the east is the Wiregrass at Stone Oak apartment complex and on the west side is The Canyons of Stone Oak Retirement Home that is currently not occupied and on the market.

The feasibility study was performed, and ARCSA purchased the land in May 2024.

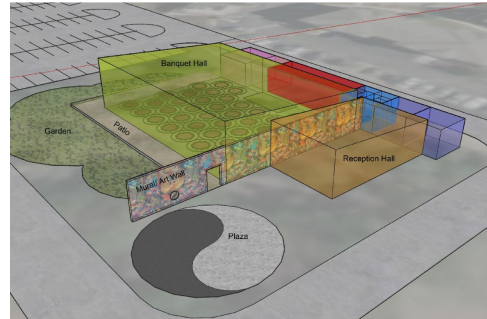
Project Development

Planned as a two-phase project, the Asian Resource Center will consist of two buildings, an outdoor patio, a plaza, and a garden. Phase I will include a multi-functional facility of 9,500 square feet that consists of event space to hold 400 to 450 people, food preparation area, and office space for community meetings, workshops, and training sessions and classes.

Phase II will have approximately 10,000 square feet of additional space for exhibition, educational programs, and workforce development activities. The garden and the plaza are currently scheduled to be in Phase II, but depending on the capital funds raised, they could be part of Phase I development.



The Asian Resource Center would create an atmosphere that seamlessly fuses modern aesthetics with traditional Asian elements, embodying the essence of East and West. The center's walls will be adorned with artwork that showcases the diversity of Asian heritage, ranging from calligraphy to contemporary paintings. A multimedia display in the lobby area offers a virtual journey through the landscapes, festivals, and traditions of Asian countries.



Proposed Project Schedule

- Land Under Contract - January 2024
- Land Feasibility Study - January 2024 to April 2024
- Close Land Purchase - May 2024
- Land Dedication - May 2025
- Design - April 2025 to December 2025
- Construction Start - January 2026
- Substantial Completion - June 2027
- Operation - September 2027

2025 Annual Gala

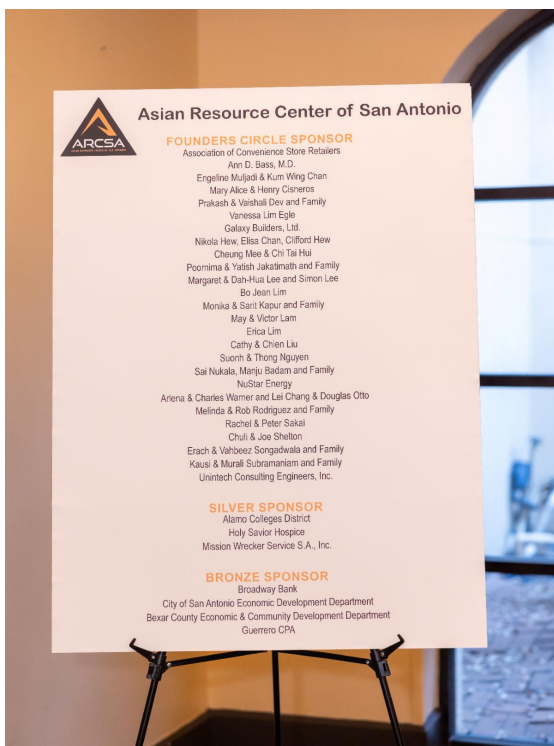
