
Land Blessing and Dedication Ceremony



2025 City Council Election

Participating in local elections is one of the most impactful ways to shape the future of our community. City council members make critical decisions that influence our daily lives—from public safety and traffic to utility rates, parks, and library services. By researching the candidates and casting your vote on May 3, 2025, you ensure that your voice is heard and that your elected officials represent your values and priorities.

We have five open council seats: Mayor, District 4, District 6, District 8, and District 9. To find out which City Council district you live in, click here.

The May municipal elections will be the first election in which council members and the mayor are elected to serve four-year terms.

The early voting starts on April 22nd to April 29th. The Election Day is Saturday, May 3rd from 7am to 7pm.
